Steps

- Forest inventory/Assessment
- Forest Resilience
- Ash proportion
- Timing (years till infestation)
- Planning #, types of entries
- Harvest & cleanup
- Restoration

Resilience

- Ability of forest to resist change from stressor pressure
 - Draining or flooding a swamp
 - Intense grazing
 - Climate change
 - EAB

Management Options

- No action
- Ash Protection/Treatment
- Safety Only
- Developed or unplanned use
- Economic management/salvage
- Influence forest development

Strategic Approaches

- Harvest
- Arboricultural
- Combined

Costs

Harvest System

Methods and equipment used to cut trees, move the wood to landing and haul to user (mill).

- Chain saw/ harvester
- Leave at stump or skid & Forward to landing with truck access
- Pre process or haul to "mill"
- Cleanup/ Chipping?

Common Harvest System

Independent logger

- Cable Skidder
 - Feller
 - Skidder Operator
 - Sorter (landing)
